# WHAT IS THE LCMS?



## Synod

- "Synod" means "walking together"
- Congregations joined together to form the Synod and relate to one another through it
- Association of Lutheran congregations and its agencies
- "Members" are congregations, pastors and commissioned ministers



## Voting Members

A number of congregations will form a group to be represented by two voting delegates:

- One Pastor
- One Lay Delegate

  - DCE, DCO



### 5 Regions

- LCMS Board of Directors and COP designate regions 24 months prior to convention
- Used for elections requiring regional representation
- Regional positions for Vice-Presidents, LCMS Board of Directors, Boards for National and International Mission

### Conditions of LCMS Membership



- Acceptance of the confessional basis of Article II.

- Regular call of pastors, teachers, and other church workers
- Regular election of lay delegates by the congregations
- Exclusive use of doctrinally pure agenda, hymnbooks, and catechisms in church and school
- Congregation's constitution contains nothing contrary to Scripture and the Confessions

# NATIONAL CONVENTION



### National Convention



- Opportunities for worship, nurture, inspiration, fellowship, communication
- Principal legislative assembly
- Amends Constitution and Bylaws
- Considers and takes action on reports and overtures
- Handles appropriate appeals
- Establishes general positions and policies of the Synod

### National Convention



- Evaluates positions, programs, policies, directions, priorities to provide responsible service on behalf of its members
- Authorize affiliation, association, discontinuance with other church bodies, synods, or federations.
- Elects national officers and members of boards and commissions.

# **CONVENTION BUSINESS**



### Convention Business

- 367 overtures submitted
- 35 district reports + 39 other reports
- Overtures are proposed resolutions requesting action by the convention
- Overtures and reports in Convention Workbook used to prepare resolutions for convention consideration.

# SERVING AS A VOTING DELEGATE



### Serving as a Voting Delegate

#### **Functions**

- Serve a three-year term beginning with convention
- Advisory member of the circuit forum
- Shall serve as a resource person in the circuit
- Assist in the dissemination of information about resolutions as well as implementation of resolutions of the Synod in the circuit



## Serving as a Voting Delegate

#### Responsibilities

- Responsible to their circuit
- Shall attempt to discover the sentiment of the circuit members
- Congregations shall not require delegates to vote in accordance with specific instructions
- Permitted to vote according to his/her own conviction
- Faithfull attendance to all convention sessions
- Shall report the actions of the Synod to their circuit after convention (preferably appearing before each congregation they represent)

#### Process

- Election opens June 22 (4 weeks prior to convention)
- Ballot of three:
  - Matthew C. Harrison
  - David P.E. Maier
  - Timothy M. Klinkenberg
- Two voting delegates (pastor and layperson) from each congregation will vote via a secure online system.

## Election of President

#### Results

- If no candidate receives a majority, a second vote takes place on June 29.
- The election results must be released to the candidates at least 2 weeks prior to the convention (July 6) and thereafter (as soon as possible) to the public.


